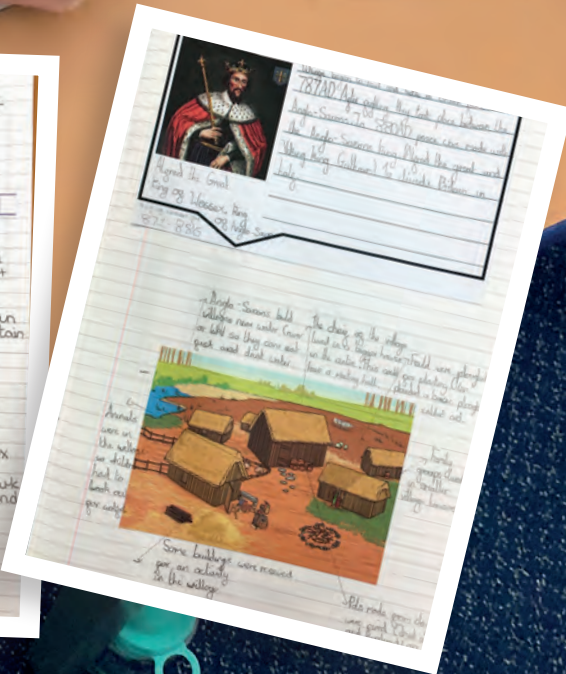
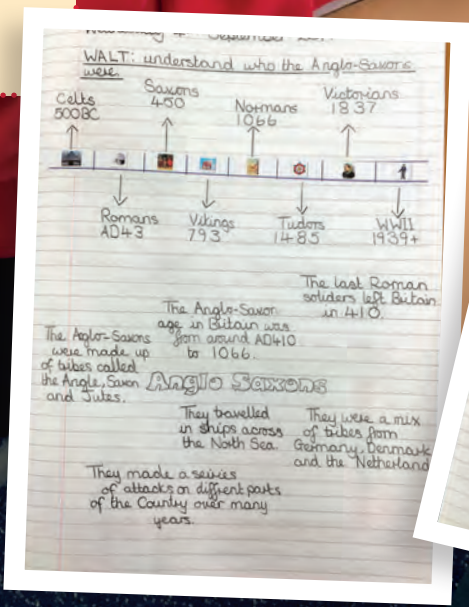
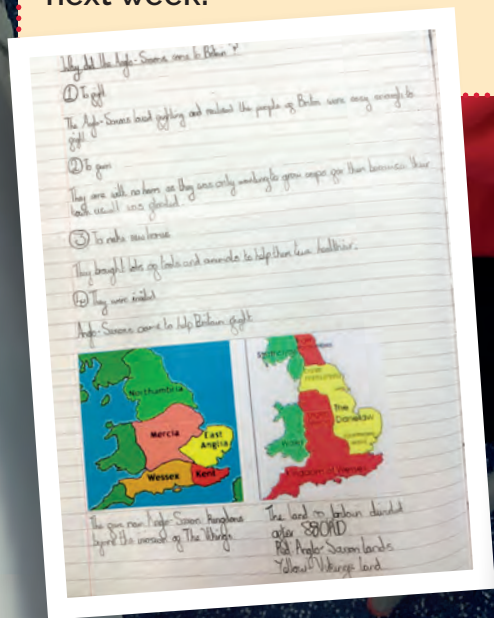


## What a fabulous first week we have all had in Year 5!
