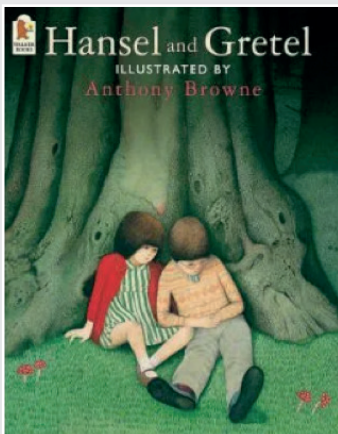

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Geography

- use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied
- use the 8 points of a compass, 4- and 6-figure grid references, symbols and key (including the use of Ordnance Survey maps) to build their knowledge of the United Kingdom and the wider world
- **Human geography**, including: types of settlement and land use, economic activity including trade links, and the distribution of natural resources including energy, food, minerals and water

Science

Pupils should be taught to:

- describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans;
- identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions

Art

Pupils should be taught:

- to create sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas;
- to improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials - study of artist Andy Goldsworthy – focus on how nature is used on sculptures
